









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

- Training courses (ToT) on water governance and water diplomacy will be provided by European partner universities for teaching staff and for students of Central Asia Partner Universities.
- Programme for continuous training and research on water governance and water diplomacy to assess the needs and capacities of the Central Asian Partner Universities will strengthen the sustainability of the project








### Brief information about the Students' Research Competition & Writing Seminar Series

- Authors of the best abstracts take part in the writing seminar series starting in January 2024 with an Info session where participants receive general information about the seminar and paper submission guidelines for the <u>Central</u> <u>Asian Journal of Water Research (CAJWR)</u>.








### TARGET GROUP of the Students' Research Competition & Writing Seminar Series
