CELEBRATION OF THE AMU DARYA RIVER DAY IN TURKMENISTAN

Event format: in-person participation

Overview: The goal of the USAID Regional Water and Vulnerable Environment Activity is to strengthen regional capacity to manage transboundary water resources and reduce environmental risks in the Syrdarya and Amudarya river basins.

In 2022, the USAID Regional Water and Vulnerable Environment Activity supported a series of events at the national and regional levels to celebrate Syr Darya River Day. A series of 5 events at the national and regional levels brought together more than 1300 participants - representatives of ministries, departments, local administrations, scientists, and youth - to discuss issues related to water management and find ways to address these issues.

In 2023, the Activity plans to hold celebration events in the Amu Darya River basin. Events will be held both at the regional and national levels in the countries of the basin. In Turkmenistan, the celebration of the Amu Darya River Day is planned in the city of Dashoguz. Preliminary to the celebration, the Activity initiated a drawing contest among students of art schools in Turkmenistan and the winners were determined, whose works will be exhibited and the prizes will be awarded as part of the event. In addition, together with the Turkmen Agricultural Institute, the Activity plans to organize a clean-up event along the riverbank of the Shavat Canal and plant trees at a pilot site in Akdepe etrap, Dashoguz region.

Goals of the event:

- raising awareness about the importance of protecting and managing water resources;
- involvement of youth in water management issues;
- strengthening regional cooperation among the countries of the basin.
