## **GOAL**

To contribute to strengthening capacity and support mutual learning across watersheds, sectors, and states, thus facilitating the experience exchange and cooperation among five countries in

## **OBJECTIVES**

- To improve knowledge among state government representatives throughout Central Asia on the Water-Energy-Food-Ecosystem Nexus (WEFE Nexus) approach.
- To strengthen regional cooperation around WEFE Nexus issues.











## **RESULTS**

- Developed a learning methodology for WEFE Nexus assessment.
- Developed six case studies for applying the WEFE Nexus approach for Central Asia.
- Conducted 5 training of trainers (ToT) sessions on teaching the WEFE Nexus approach to more than 130 participants in Central Asian countries.
- Organized a regional seminar on the WEFE Nexus approach for approximately 80 participants from Central Asian countries.
- · Signed memoranda of cooperation with the Academy of Public Administration under the President of the Kyrgyz Republic and the Tajik Agrarian University named after Sh. Shotemur.
- Developed an open online course on WEFE Nexus assessment, now available to students at all Central Asian universities and for specialists in all WEFE Nexus related fields: https://edu.dku.kz/course/view.php?id=4
